Answers to Harassment Scenarios #2

Situation#1: Group of Girls vs. Ex- Friend: -- Direct and indirect; Social Harassment-Using their status to get what they want by ignoring, spreading rumors and teasing her.

Situation #2: Student being bullied at recess:—direct; biased; using power and control-age harassment

Situation #3: Student being harassed for low grades. Indirect; Cyber bullying- Using technology to be mean.

Situation #4: Inappropriate language on the bathroom stall. Direct; Visual Sexual harassment: Unwelcome and unwanted sexual behavior.
