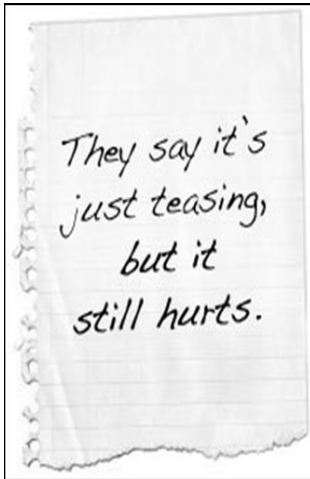


Stop Harassment from Happening!

Power-Driven

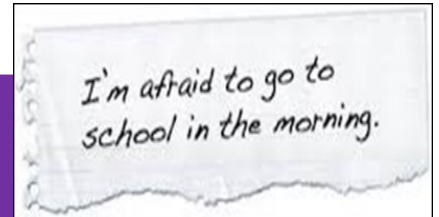
Older

Making you feel less about who you are as a person

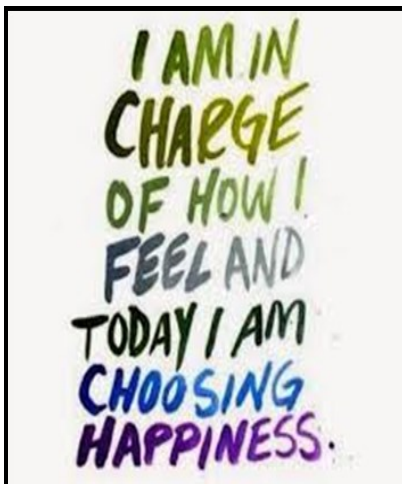


Socially-Driven



USING TECHNOLOGY TO THREATEN, INTIMIDATE OR HARASS

wants to be friends with you anymore.



Cyberbullying
Using the Internet to harass; spreading rumors, sharing inappropriate emails, messages, videos, etc.

Visual
Comments written on lockers, binders or bathroom stalls. Unwanted staring or winking. Inappropriate pictures or words on school computers

Physical
Hitting, kicking, pushing, punching, slapping, etc.

Forms of Harassment

Sexual
Unwanted or unwelcome sexual behavior

Emotional/Social
Spreading rumors, leaving people out, gossiping and harming someone's reputation

Verbal
Name calling, threatening, nasty or hurtful comments, racial slurs and rude comments
