<u>UnSafe Touches</u>: Unsafe touches are the parts covered by swimming suits, or touches to other people's swimming suit areas. No one should touch you there.

<u>Shout, Run & Tell:</u> If anyone ever makes us feel uncomfortable or unsafe by coming into our personal space we have to Shout, Run and Tell. Shout at them to stop, run away, and tell a grown-up.

<u>It Doesn't Matter Who it is:</u> If anyone ever tries to touch us on a private part of our bodies, they are not safe friends, and they aren't trusted grown-ups.

<u>Stranger Safety:</u> We don't talk to strangers without a safe adult's permission. We don't accept food or gifts from strangers without a safe adult's permission. We never go anywhere with strangers.

<u>Hitting is wrong:</u> This rule reminds us that kids should never get touches that hurt.
